2020 Reminders

We play Monday afternoons, with a practice round starting at 3:30 pm on April 13, league play will start April 20. Please schedule your tee time, between 3:30 and 5 PM, at the Clubhouse. You do not always need a partner or a group of 4 to play. We meet at the first hole and play in groups of 3 or 4 so that no one plays alone.

Handicaps: One of the advantages of playing in a league is to obtain a USPGA handicap through the Golf Handicap and Information Network (GHIN). Once the requirements have been completed, you will receive a GHIN number. This will allow you to post scores at the clubhouse and online. You will also receive emails on the 1st and 15th of every month with an updated handicap. You need to establish a handicap by July 1 to be eligible to play in the Club Championship in late July/early August.

Weekly Play: To make things fun, we play different tournaments (fun names for rounds of golf). Each week you will receive an email that will include the winners from the previous week and the email will also include the tournament scheduled that week. Not to worry, there will be instruction sheets each week at the clubhouse and always someone to ask if you have questions.

Some definitions that will help you wade through the registration, or serve as reminder:

Kickers: Each week there will be a jar of quarters on the table. If you want to, place a quarter in the jar and enter your name on the sign up sheet. At the end of the night a number between 1-9 will be picked. Everyone who has a gross score ending with the picked number will be a winner and share the quarters in that week's jar. Winners' envelopes will be placed on the bulletin board in the Clubhouse.

Chits: Gift certificates to be used at the Clubhouse to purchase merchandise. You win a chit by winning a weekly tournament. They, too, will be placed in envelopes on the bulletin board.

Ringers: Kind of like "fantasy golf". If you paid an extra \$2.00 when you joined, you are eligible to enter this game. Each week you enter your score on the Ringer Board. If your score improves on a hole in following weeks, you erase the old score and enter the new one. The winners will be announced at the end of season banquet.

Water Jar: Each week there will be a jar of dimes on the table. After your round, if your tee shot landed in the water on the 4th hole, place a dime in the jar. The dimes accumulate and the total funds will be awarded at the end of season banquet.

Hole in One: If you chose to participate in the Hole in One Tournament, with registration, pay an additional \$1.00. That \$1.00 goes into an "insurance" fund and keeps growing until it pays out to someone that makes a Hole in One. This helps the person pay for the customary "round of drinks" when they accomplish this rare feat!
